

## **A net (gathering of works) of good and bad fish**

**Matt. 13:47-50** "Again, the kingdom of the heavens is like to a net that was cast into the sea, and a variety of species were gathered into the midst and when it was full, they brought it up to the seashore, then they sat down and collected the good species in the midst of vessels, but they threw the bad ones away. So it shall be at the end of the age. The messengers shall go forth and separate the wicked from among the righteous, and they shall cast them into the furnace of fire, where there shall be wailing and grinding of teeth." **Every mortal man has his knowledge (gathering/production) of good (fish) and bad (fish) and come to the end of his fleshly age when His net/second coming cast into the sea (heart) to gather all his works of mortality. All his works of goodness (good fish) are reaped into His Kingdom of Life, but his works of evilness (bad fish) are taken out to the kingdom of death (dust).**

**1Cor3:15** If anyone's work shall be consumed, he shall suffer loss; but he himself shall be saved, yet so as through fire. **Only the works of lawlessness/wickedness are thrown out of the net into the furnace of fire (kingdom of death). The works of righteousness are stored in His Kingdom of Life. The net is like a gathering of your works both of righteousness and wickedness like the parable of wheat and tares together till the time of the harvest (end of your fleshly life).**
