

Eternities are written in the Scriptures

Generations: **Genesis 9:12-13** Elohim said, This is the sign of the covenant which I am making between Me and you and between every living creature that is with you, for the everlasting generations; I set My bow in the cloud, and it shall be for a sign of a covenant between Me and the earth.

No man's doctrine such as the rapture or unbeliever's doctrine can break His promise/sign of a covenant between Him and the earth for the everlasting generations.

(other versions often use all successive, all future, perpetual, to come, continuous)

אֶלֹהִים is His Name: **Ex3:15** Elohim, furthermore, said to Mosheh, Thus you shall say to the sons of Yisra'el, אֶלֹהִים, the El of your fathers, the El of Abraham, the El of Yitschaq, and the El of Ya'aqob, has sent me to you. This is My name forever, and this is My memorial for generation to generation.

Word: **Ex12:24** And you shall observe this word as an ordinance for you and your children forever.

Earth: **Ecclesiastes 1:4** A generation goes and a generation comes, but the earth remains forever."

Passover: **Exodus 12:11** Thus you shall eat it with your loins girded, your sandals on your feet, and your staff in your hand; and you shall eat it in haste - it is the Passover to אֶלֹהִים. **14** Now this day shall be a memorial to you, and you shall celebrate it as a feast to אֶלֹהִים; throughout your generations you shall celebrate it as an ordinance forever.

Feast of Unleavened bread: **Exodus 12:17** You shall observe the Feast of Unleavened Bread, for on this very day I brought your hosts out of the land of Mitsrayim; you shall observe this day throughout your generations as an ordinance forever.

Shavuot: **Leviticus 23:15-22** You shall count for yourselves from the day after the Shabbat, from the day that you brought the sheaf of the wave offering: seven Shabbats shall be completed. Count fifty days to the day after the seventh Shabbat; then you shall offer a new grain offering to YHWH.

Sukkot: **Leviticus 23:39-43**You shall keep it as a feast to YHWH for seven days in the year. It shall be a statue forever in your generations. You shall celebrate it in the seventh month. You shall dwell in booths for seven days.

Three times in a year: **Deut. 16:16** Three times in a year all your males shall appear before אֶלֹהִים your El in the place which He chooses it, at the Feast of Unleavened Bread and at the Feast of Shabbuot and at the Feast of Sukkot, and they shall not appear before אֶלֹהִים empty-handed.

Chodesh: **Isaiah 66:23** It shall come to pass, that from one new moon (Chodesh) to another, and from one Shabbat to another, shall all flesh come to worship before Me, says YHWH. **Psalms 72:5** Let them fear You while the sun endures, and as long as the moon, throughout all generations.

Shabbat: **Exodus 31:16** Wherefore the children of Yisrael shall keep the Shabbat, to observe the Shabbat throughout their generations; for a perpetual covenant.

Salvation: **Isaiah 45:17-19** "But Israel shall be saved by YHWH with an everlasting salvation: you shall not be ashamed nor confounded world without end."

Mercy: **Psalms 103:17** "But the mercy of YHWH is from everlasting to everlasting upon them fear Him, and His righteousness unto children's children." **Forgiveness and mercy are strongly connected: Mercy is a combination of forgiveness, benevolence, and compassion. Forgiveness is a positive feeling.**

Kingdom: **Psalms 145:13** "The kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations."

Judgment: **Psalms 119:160** "Your word is true from the beginning; and every one of Your righteous judgments endures for ever."

Mercy and Truth: **Psalms 100:5** "For YHWH is good; His mercy is everlasting; and His truth endures to all generations."

Kindness: **Luke 1:50** "And His kindness/mercy/compassion endures from generation to generations to those who fear Him."

Generation: **Eph3:20-21** And the One who is able to increase His rewards over us more than all what we ask or what we think, according to the power that works within us, to Him be the glory within the assembly and in the Mashiyach **וְעַל־כָּל־דָּבָר** for generation and generation forever and ever. Amen.

Gospel: **Revelation 14:6?** "And I saw another messenger flying in the middle of the heavens, having an eternal good news (gospel) in his mouth to preach those who live on the earth, even to every nation and tribe and tongue and people".

Yahushua the Mashiyach: **Hebrews 13:8** Yahushua the Mashiyach is the same yesterday and today and forever.

He is the Alpha and the Tau (Omega) for the eternal generations spoken in Genesis 9:12-13 and His eternal mercy in Psalms 103:17 and His eternal salvation in Isaiah 45:17-19 and the eternal Gospel (Revelation 14:6).

What is meant that He is the same daily even back to 2000 years ago and today and for ever?

Yahushua the Mashiyach is an excellent example showing us from the time of His teaching of the repentance required for all the people, His seed of faith sown in the repentant heart, His baptism, His parables for all to understand the spiritual teachings, His fulfillment of obedience to His Law of Life, upon our repentance out of the kingdom of darkness, our sins are nailed in His crucifixion to carry to His death and His resurrection of Life. We are the spiritual births at His Aleph coming upon our repentance and His sanctification, His seed of faith to sow in our hearts, His Holy Spirit (Helper) given to us (Rev. 3:20, John 3:13 and 16:7), our gifts of holiness to work for Him, our spiritual growth of perceiving His parables and His Law of Life during the shortened days on the earth, and at His Tau coming to harvest fully out of our seed of faith sown at the time of our fleshly death.

He will continue with His Alpha and Tau comings forever for every repentant one in order to make a spiritual birth to dwell on the earth for the shortened days until his/her death.

His everlasting sanctification are upon our hearts when coming to our spiritual births upon our repentance and His spiritual laws are written on our sanctified hearts where Yahushua our Mashiyach our eternal King reigns over us. His Law of love protects us eternally against the lawlessness thru our faithfulness in obedience to all His commands.

For the eternal generations mentioned in Genesis 9:12-13, we, His People that are called out of the kingdom of darkness upon our repentance to serve YHWH our El, are the children of His resurrection for ever (Luke 20:36).
