

Seven trumpets:

First trumpet (Our spiritual battle against the spirits of lawlessness):

Rev. 8:7 "The first sounded, and there came hail and fire, mixed with blood, and they were thrown to the earth; and a third of the earth was burned up, and a third of the trees were burned up, and all the green grass was burned up."

Luke 12:49-50 "I have come to cast fire upon the earth; and how I wish it were already kindled! But I have a baptism to undergo, and how distressed I am until it is accomplished!"; Matt. 23:32-36 "Fill up, then, the measure of the guilt of your fathers. You serpents, you brood of vipers, how will you escape the sentence of hell? Therefore, behold, I am sending you prophets and wise men and scribes; some of them you will kill and crucify, and some of them you will scourge in your synagogues, and persecute from city to city, so that upon you may fall the guilt of all the righteous blood shed on earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah, the son of Berechiah, whom you murdered between the temple and the altar. Truly I say to you, all these things will come upon this generation."; Eph. 6:12-13 "For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the powers, against the world forces of this darkness, against the spiritual forces of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore, take up the full armor of Elohim, so that you will be able to resist in the evil day, and having done everything, to stand firm."

His works of wrath are hail (plagues/sickness), consuming fire (judgment), and blood (guiltiness) on those who do the deeds of lawlessness in this world (today's generation) of mortality. These three things burnt up (consumed) are the earth (unrepentant heart on words of darkness), trees (kingdoms of evilness), and green grass (works of lawlessness). Luke 10:18 "And He said to them, I was watching Satan fall from heaven like lightning."; Rev. 12:4 "And his tail swept away a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth. And the dragon stood before the woman who was about to give birth, so that when she gave birth he might devour her child."
What the three things of Satan's tail (kingdom of lawlessness) fall down upon our repentance are to war against us because we keep His Law of Life by this world of lawlessness (unrepentant hearts of those who serve Satan), the trees of knowledge of evilness, and green grass (works of lawlessness).

As we receive His spirit of Life into our sanctified heart/temple, we are separated from the world of lawlessness while in the trials of our spiritual bodies (kingdoms) fighting with His might against the powers of lawlessness, keeping His Law of Life. His completion of His 7 trumpets restores us back to His Kingdom of Life from the fleshly heart of demonic possessions in the fleshly body of sin (kingdom of death/lawlessness).

Second trumpet (Our knowledge and labor of evilness thrown into the sea/lake of fire):

Rev. 8:8-9 "The second angel sounded, and something like a great mountain burning with fire was thrown into the sea; and a third of the sea became blood, and a third of the creatures which were in the sea and had life, died; and a third of the ships were destroyed."

Matt. 21:21-22 "And Yahushua answered and said to them, "Truly I say to you, if you have faith and do not doubt, you will not only do what was done to the fig tree, but even if you say to this mountain, Be taken up and cast into the sea, it will happen. And all things you ask in prayer, believing, you will receive."; 1 Peter 1:6-7 "In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials, so that the proof of your faith, being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Yahushua haMashiyach."

A great mountain (the foundation/knowledge of mortality built) examined by His judgment (consuming fire) is thrown to the sea (lake of fire) which is perishable once you come to know His foundation of immortality upon your repentance. The sea (lake of fire) is the collection of all works of abomination consumed and thrown out of the repentant hearts. The three things seen in every mortal heart are the words of guiltiness (blood), the spirits of uncleanness (creatures/works), and the fleshly powers/wealth (ships).

As we are tested in obeying His Law of Life in the process to complete His work (7 days), more fleshly powers are fallen out while growing in our spiritual life. Rev. 3:10 "Because you have kept the word of My perseverance, I also will keep you from the hour of testing, that hour which is about to come upon the whole world, to test those who dwell on the earth."

Third trumpet (Our fleshly works consumed/wormed while growth in Messiah):

Rev. 8:10-11 "The third angel sounded, and a great star fell from heaven, burning like a torch, and it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of waters. The name of the star is called Wormwood; and a third of the waters became wormwood, and many men died from the waters, because they were made bitter."; Luke 10:18 "And He said to them, I was watching Satan fall from heaven like lightning."

As we increase our faithfulness in His powers by prevailing our spiritual strengths in His Kingdom of Life, He purges more works of fleshly destruction as He sees the hearts of mortal men that have the fleshly possessions dominated by Satan. Satan, the wormwood, is the father of worthlessness, for many spirits of lawlessness (third of the waters) fall away (die) while growing our spiritual life in Messiah. All the works of lawlessness are consumed/wormed by His Word of Life. Rev. 12:4 "And his tail swept away a third of the stars of heaven and threw them to the earth..."; 2 Cor. 4:16 "Therefore we do not lose heart, but though our outer man is decaying, yet our inner man is being renewed day by day." **What measured of Satan's tail (kingdom of lawlessness) of his three things of opposition are thrown to the earth (bottomless pit/abyss) upon our repentance are against His Kingdom of Life in us. We, the spiritual minded, drink His living water daily as His Spirit of Life teaches us to do His Law of Life.**

Fourth trumpet (Three things of darkness thrown to earth upon our repentance):

Rev. 8:12-13 "The fourth angel sounded, and a third of the sun and a third of the moon and a third of the stars were struck, so that a third of them would be darkened and the day would not shine for a third of it, and the night in the same way. Then I looked, and I heard an eagle flying in midheaven, saying with a loud voice, "Woe, woe, woe to those who dwell on the earth, because of the remaining blasts of the trumpet of the three angels who are about to sound!"

John 12:46 "I have come as Light into the world, so that everyone who believes in Me will not remain in darkness."

We are the children of His Light (spiritual bodies), while our fleshly bodies of darkness are put under His feet (abyss) as His Light dominates over the darkness. John 1:4-5 "In Him was life, and the life was the Light of men. The Light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it."

As Satan's tail (dominion) sweep away the three parts from the sky, they are the darkened sun (kingdom of darkness), the bloodied moon (body of uncleanness) and the fallen stars (spirits of lawlessness) upon the repentance out of Satan's kingdom to His Kingdom of Light. The day of mortality becomes the night when coming to His day of immortality by awakening out of the kingdom of mortality. Yahushua the Messiah is the head of His people chosen out of the world of lawlessness upon their repentance and Satan is the tail of his evil followers as His enemies are under His feet forever.

Fifth trumpet (Our kingdoms/bodies of lawlessness put under His feet/bottomless pit):

Rev. 9:1-3 "Then the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star from heaven which had fallen to the earth; and the key of the bottomless pit was given to him. He opened the bottomless pit, and smoke went up out of the pit, like the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by the smoke of the pit. Then out of the smoke came locusts upon the earth, and power was given them, as the scorpions of the earth have power."

1 Cor. 5:4-5 kjv "In the name of our Master Yahushua Messiah, when ye are gathered together, and my spirit, wit the power of our Master Yahushua Messiah, to deliver such an one unto Satan for the destruction of the flesh, that his spirit may be saved in the day of the Master Yahushua."; 27 "For He has put all things in subjection under His feet. But when He says, All things are put in subjection, it is evident that He is excepted who put all things in subjection to Him."; Matt. 16:18-19 "I also say to you that you are Kepha, and upon this rock I will build My assembly; and the gates of Hades will not overpower it. I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven; and whatever you bind on earth shall have been bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth shall have been loosed in heaven."

All our fleshly bodies (kingdoms of lawlessness) must be subjected under His feet upon our repentance so we can serve Him in our spiritual bodies. Our repentance brings down Satan from his dominion (power of air [Eph. 2:2-3]) to the earth (bottomless pit) where His enemies are under His feet, for we are the members of His resurrected body. We, the spiritual minded, has His keys of Kingdom of heaven to authorized over the powers of evilness under our feet. The scorpions and locusts of the earth are the spirits of lawlessness out of the kingdom of mortality subjected to us as we rebuke them while keeping His Law of Life.

Sixth trumpet (His deliverance of us to His living waters):

Rev. 9:13-14 "Then the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before Elohim, one saying to the sixth angel who had the trumpet, Release the four angels who are bound at the great river Euphrates."

Gen. 15:18 "On that day YHWH made a covenant with Abram, saying, To your descendants I have given this land, from the river of Egypt as far as the great river, the river Euphrates."; Ex. 23:31-32 "I will fix your boundary from the Red Sea to the sea of the Philistines, and from the wilderness to the River Euphrates; for I will deliver the inhabitants of the land into your hand, and you will drive them out before you. You shall make no covenant with them or with their elohim."; Josh. 1:3-5 "Every place on which the sole of your foot treads, I have given it to you, just as I spoke to Moshe. From the wilderness and this Lebanon, even as far as the great river, the river Euphrates, all the land of the Hittites, and as far as the Great Sea toward the setting of the sun will be your territory. No man will be able to stand before you all the days of your life. Just as I have been with Moshe, I will be with you; I will not fail you or forsake you."; 1 King 14:15-16 "For YHWH will strike Yisrael, as a reed is shaken in the water; and He will uproot Yisrael from this good land which He gave to their fathers, and will scatter them beyond the Euphrates River, because they have made their Asherim, provoking YHWH to anger. He will give up Yisrael on account of the sins of Jeroboam, which he committed and with which he made Yisrael to sin." **What YHWH has measured (fixed)**

our spiritual boundary from the Red Sea (our spiritual baptism/repentance out of the Egypt/kingdom of darkness) to the sea of Philistines (our fleshly bodies buried) to the wilderness (our spiritual trials in Messiah) to His living water (the river Euphrates), where the four angels/His guardians are of our spiritual boundary from our baptism in Messiah to drink of His living waters. What is beyond the river Euphrates is outside of our spiritual boundary in which all our works of lawlessness are perished.

Rom. 6:19-23 "I am speaking in human terms because of the weakness of your flesh. For just as you presented your members as slaves to impurity and to lawlessness, resulting in further lawlessness, so now present your members as slaves to righteousness, resulting in sanctification. For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. Therefore what benefit were you then deriving from the things of which you are now ashamed? For the outcome of those things is death. But now having been freed from sin and enslaved to Elohim, you derive your benefit, resulting in sanctification, and the outcome, eternal life. For the wages of sin is death, but the free gift of Elohim is eternal life in haMashiyach Yahushua our Master."

His sanctification is to separate us, the spiritual bodies/kingdoms, from the fleshly bodies/kingdoms under His feet (abyss) as all the unrepentant spirits (powers) of lawlessness are perished into the lake of fire (kingdom of death).

Seventh trumpet (Our spiritual kingdoms/production are His Kingdom/possession of Life):

Rev. 10:7 "but in the days of the voice of the seventh angel, when he is about to sound, then the mystery of Elohim is finished, as He preached to His servants the prophets.", 11:15 "Then the seventh angel sounded; and there were loud voices in heaven, saying, "The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Adoneynu and of His Mashiyach; and He will reign forever and ever."

Mark 3:26 "If Satan has risen up against himself and is divided, he cannot stand, but he is finished!"; Eph. 1:9-10 "He made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His kind intention which He purposed in Him with a view to an administration suitable to the fullness of the times, that is, the summing up of all things in haMashiyach, things in the heavens and things on the earth."; John 19:30 "...He said, .It is finished!.."

As He completes His work in us to finish the mystery, we will become His immortal servants with His Spirit of Life caught up with Him at the ends of our fleshly ages, like He yielded His spirit at His crucifixion, saying "It is finished!". All spiritual births begin with the first heavenly trumpet rejoicing over the repentant ones in receiving His Spirit of Life into their sanctified hearts and have their shortened days during their spiritual trials till the ends of fleshly ages before they are received up with Him as His 7th trumpet is sounded. What His Word of Life is sown out of His Kingdom of Light in our sanctified hearts become His eternal possession of our spiritual production in obeying His Law of Life.

1 Cor. 15: 51-54 "Now I say this, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of Elohim; nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable. Behold, I tell you a mystery; we will not all sleep, but we will all be changed, in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the **last (7th) trumpet**; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. For this perishable must put on the imperishable, and this mortal must put on immortality." **The last (7th) trumpet is sounded in the moment that we will be changed from the perishable/mortal body to His imperishable body (members of our Messiah) at the ends of our fleshly ages.**

The first trumpet is sounded upon our repentance from our former kingdoms of lawlessness to His Kingdom of Life as we are raised from the dead in Messiah (perishable body) to become new members of His resurrected (imperishable) body alive and remain on the earth to build our spiritual life for the shortened days till the ends of our fleshly ages, before we can be caught up with Him in the air.

Seven seals, seven trumpets, seven vials (bowls of His wrath):

Rev. 5:1 "I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a book written inside and on the back, sealed up with seven seals."; 8:2 "And I saw the seven angels who stand before Elohim, and seven trumpets were given to them."; 16:1 "Then I heard a loud voice from the temple, saying to the seven angels, "Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the wrath of Elohim."

It is understood that the number seven is sanctified to free us from the kingdom of unrest (lawlessness) if we obey His Law of Shabbat. The 28th chapter of Deuteronomy speaks of the blessings and cursings when we obey His Law of Life or not. James 1:2-4 "Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing."; 1 Peter 1:6-7 "In this you greatly rejoice, even though now for a little while, if necessary, you have been distressed by various trials, so that the proof of your faith, being more precious than gold which is perishable, even though tested by fire, may be found to result in praise and glory and honor at the revelation of Yahushua haMashiyach." **Everyone must be in the trials of his faithfulness till the end of fleshly age as to measure his valuation of obedience to His Law of Life for his spiritual body (kingdom) that is handed to His Kingdom of Life while his valuation of disobedience (lawlessness) is measured to the kingdom of death.** Rom. 2:9-10 "There will be tribulation and distress for every soul of man who does evil (fleshly minded), of the Jew first and also of the Greek, but glory and honor and peace to everyone who does good (spiritual minded), to the Jew first and also to the Greek." **The Jew (house of Yisrael/Yahudah [Judah]) and the Gentile/Greek (house of Ephrayim) that were divided from the kingdom of Shelomoh (Solomon) are His two witnesses to preach to all in the world of mortality.**

Seven seals:

First, we repent from the kingdom of lawlessness dominated by Satan from our fleshly births, so we become His sealed servants to separate from the kingdom of slavery (bitterness, wrath, anger) by keeping His Law of Life. 2 Cor. 1:21-22 "Now He who establishes us with you in haMashiyach and anointed us is Elohim, who also sealed us and gave us the Spirit in our hearts as a pledge."; Eph. 5:30-31 "Do not grieve Ruach haKodesh of Elohim, by whom you were sealed for the day of redemption. Let all bitterness and wrath and anger and clamor and slander be put away from you, along with all malice."

Seven trumpets:

Our spiritual trumpet is to overcome all the works of lawlessness completely during the trials of our spiritual growth on His Rock of perfection before our fleshly expiration by our transformation from the kingdom of mortality to His Kingdom of immortality, when our perishable body of sin is dead and our imperishable body of His glory is caught up with Him. 1 Cor. 15:52 "in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last (7th) trumpet; for the trumpet will sound, and the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed."; Rev. 11:15 "The kingdoms of the world have become the kingdom of our Master and of His Messiah."

Seven bowls of wrath:

No one (fleshly minded) is able to receive His temple of holiness in his heart of mortality, unless all the works of lawlessness are removed completely in the repentant heart for the shortened days till the end of fleshly age, so the spiritual minded cannot be hurt by all the spirits of lawlessness.

Lastly, we, the spiritual bodies, are completely freed from the fleshly bodies at the ends of our fleshly ages as His immortal coming (harvest) strikes (blow out) the kingdom of mortality (death). His complete wrath is done at the end of Satan's kingdom to finish his work of imperfection during the spiritual trials before the fleshly body is left and the spiritual body is taken up at the end of fleshly age.

15:8 "And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of Elohim and from His power; and no one was able to enter the temple until the seven plagues of the seven angels were finished."; 16:1 "Then I heard a loud voice from the temple, saying to the seven angels, Go and pour out on the earth the seven bowls of the wrath of Elohim.";

The number of immortal/perfect (spiritual) man is 777, for he has eaten His unleavened Bread/ Word of Life completely (7 days), has received His Spirit of Life (7 Shabbats/Shavuot), and has dwelt in His Tabernacle of eternity (7 days of Sukkot), comparing to the number of mortal/ imperfect (lawless/fleshly) man that is 666. The six seals, six trumpets, and six vials of thunder mentioned in the book of Revelation are understood as the six days of fleshly affliction, and the seventh seal (silence), the seventh trumpet (mystery of Elohim is finished) before the kingdoms of world has become His Kingdom of our Master, the seventh vial (the purgation of works of lawlessness is done by His bowls of wrath) is understood as the day of judgment/freedom to separate from all the days of fleshly affliction.

It is perceived that seven seals (repentance/removal of works of lawlessness) and seven trumpets (receipt of His Spirit of Life) that the repentant ones decrease the valuation of kingdom of lawlessness/death and increase the valuation of His Kingdom of Life. The seven vials/bowls of His wrath is perceived that the fleshly bodies (unrepentant ones) increase the valuation of the kingdom of death and must be separated from the spiritual bodies at the fleshly expiration. Matt. 10:28a "Do not fear those who kill the body but are unable to kill the soul": What is fleshly sold: Those, who fear YHWH, sell (decrease) the valuation of their fleshly bodies that are perishable (1 Cor. 5:5; Mark 10:21), and increase the spiritual things out of His Kingdom of Life in their sanctified hearts that are imperishable. 28b "but rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.": What is not fleshly sold: Those who do not sell (decrease) the valuation of their fleshly bodies and do not increase the valuation of their spiritual bodies (souls) shall be judged at the day of His judgment when the fleshly age comes to its end, but their souls are saved (1 Cor. 3:10-15).
